- 3. Turn LEFT onto LA-45/BARATARIA BLVD. (go 1.0 miles)
- 4. Turn RIGHT to stay on BARATARIA BLVD/LA-45. (go 0.6 miles)
- 5. End at 7967 Barataria Blvd Crown Point


