The next club BrewOff will be on November 12 at Richard Cuccia's house.

First CoochDome Barleywine BrewOff, Sat, 11/12/11, 4725 Chastant St, Metairie

Everyone,

Wort: Dan Thompson is brewing an **American Barleywine**, **19C**.

OG: 1.080 – 1.120, IBUs: 50 – 120, FG: 1.016 – 1.030, SRM: 10 – 19, ABV: 8 – 12%,

Dan is aiming at and is trying to achieve an **ABV of 11% or higher**. This probably means

an OG of somewhere around 1.100 or maybe, even higher. Such a high ABV requires a whole bunch of grain and 2 or 3 packs of yeast for a five-gallon wort unit.

Because the CCH brewing equipment generally handles wort yielding 5% to 6% ABV, at this time, my guess is that there will only be a wort yield of maybe/possibly be about 6 to 8 fivegallon units (30 – 40 gallons), instead of the normal 10 five-gallon units (50 gallons).

We may go to 4-gallon units with an appropriate proration of price. This will be decided soon.

Need:

- [1] **Participants** for wort. First come, first served. Contact me, ASAP.
- [2] One **equipment mover**; Travis Combel is the other equipment mover.
- [3] **Chef**.

Costs:

Wort: pro rata of grain/yeast bill. For sure - a lot of money. After Dan figures his grain/yeast bill, we will have a fair guess of the overall brewoff costs.

Food & refreshments: approx. \$8 to \$10 per person, depending on food/refreshments bill.
